

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Professional school nurses and health service staffs are members of the education team that serves the community, state, and nation, providing health services; and

WHEREAS: We share the pride in the community, state, and nation for their tireless competence, service, and leadership; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting, therefore, that we recognize the excellent contributions made to the wellness of Minnesota children and youth by these professionals working in the school environment;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim January 23, 1980 to be

MINNESOTA SCHOOL NURSE DAY

and January 20 through 26, 1980 to be

SHAPE (School Health - A Positive Environment) WEEK

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further urge all Minnesotans, all education agencies and other community organizations, as well as all news media to Join in this recognition by promoting and encouraging the goals of professional school nurses and their staffs as they contribute to the health and welfare of our communities, state, and nation.
