ORDINANCE # 118

An Ordinance amending Section 1 of Ordinance # 100 to read as follows:

Section 1. The corporate limits of the City of Chisago City, are hereby extended to include the property legally described as follows:

The South 275 feet of that part of Government Lot 6, Section 32, Township 34 North Range West, Chisago County, Minnesota, lying easterly of the following described line:


Commencing at the point of intersection of the south line of Government Lot 6 and the easterly line of old Highway 8; thence East along said south line 311.5 feet, more or less, to a point in line with the westerly line of Oak Street in A.W. Carlson's Rearrangement, said point being the point of beginning; thence North 7 degrees 37 minutes East 277.45 feet to the north line of the South 275 feet of said Government Lot 6 and there terminating.

Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance, together with the Affidavit of Publication thereof, with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Chisago County, Minnesota, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

James Hoy, being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all times herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as the Chisago County Press and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: 1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches, 2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week, 3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements, 4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second class matter in its local post office, 5) Said newspaper purports to serve the Village of Lindstrom in the county of Chisago and has its known office of issue in the Village of Lindstrom in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and devoted exclusively during such regular business hours to the business of the newspaper and business related thereto, 6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society, 7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least one year preceding the day or dates of publication listed below, 8) Said newspaper has filed with the secretary of state prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the secretary of state and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper, 9) Said newspaper was on May 20, 1965 qualified as a medium of official and legal publication and has continually thereafter met the foregoing conditions.

He further states on oath that the printed Ordinance #118
