NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special Charter Amendment election will be held in and for the City of Winona, Minnesota, in conjunction with the regular municipal election on Tuesday, the 4th day of December, 1979, between the hours of 7 A.M. and 8 P.M., at which time the following question will be submitted:

{ Shall Section 4.01 of the City Charter be amended to provide that regular municipal elections shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November of each odd numbered year, instead of December?

All registered and qualified voters of the City are entitled to vote at said election within the respective election precincts in which they reside, as heretofore established for regular municipal elections.
