



Proclamation

WHEREAS: An Office on Families within the Department of Health, Welfare, and Education has been established nationally and three co-equal White House Conferences will be held in Baltimore, Minneapolis, and Los Angeles in June, 1980; and

WHEREAS: A Minnesota White House Conference on Families Advisory Committee was appointed, followed by six Regional hearings to be held in January, 1980, throughout the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Family Service of the Greater St. Paul Area has provided quality services and programs to Minnesota families since 1892; and

WHEREAS: Family Service of the Greater St. Paul Area wishes to recognize and commend the commitment of federal, state and local government on enhancing the quality of family life, as part of its Community Open House to be held January 17, 1980;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the month of January, 1980, to be
