



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The "Environment, Agribusiness, Resources, Technologies and Horticulture Association of Minnesota" (E.A.R.T.H.) is a statewide organization dedicated towards the development of each student's social and leadership abilities, as well as his/her skills; and

WHEREAS: There is a definite need for further education in agriculture and agriculture-related fields to insure the future development of its people and economic growth; and

WHEREAS: EARTH is making continuous contributions for advancement of education in agriculture and agriculture-related fields to ensure the further development of professional and technical growth; and

WHEREAS: EARTH's main objectives are to provide occupational experience programs in all phases of the agricultural industry, to emphasize the development of leadership, citizenship, personal improvement and occupational responsibility; and

WHEREAS: This year marks the fifth anniversary of the Minnesota EARTH Association, an organization composed of 908 active members; and

WHEREAS: The 1980 theme is, "Only One EARTH, Our Earth,"
