NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim February 24, 1980 to be

SPECIAL OLYMPICS HOCKEY DAY

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further commend all citizens and participants inVolVed with this most worthwhile program.
