The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1978, Section 16.125, Subdivision 3.


The appropriate transfer of furnishings and equipment shall be made. A copy of the list of furnishings and equipment is on file in the Department of Administration.
