WHEREAS: The Hutchinson High School Band of Hutchinson, Minnesota, has consistently maintained a high level of music ability during the past years; and

WHEREAS: The Band has been the Host Band at the Hutchinson Water Carnival, which is one of the largest out-state events to take place in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: In 1978 and 1979, the Band was featured at the Valley Fair; and

WHEREAS: This year, the Hutchinson High School Band, under the direction of David W. Skaar, has been selected to represent the State of Minnesota in the 1980 music festival, "Fiesta '80", being held during the month of June, 1980, in Mexico City, Mexico; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H.
