

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Minnesota Business Educators, Inc. is sponsoring a Business Education Conference in Minneapolis on May 1, 2, and 3, 1980; and

WHEREAS: The theme for the Conference is "Issues of the 80's"; and

- WHEREAS: The observance of this Business Education Conference, in cooperation with teachers and educational training institutions on all levels, is to give emphasis to the idea of government, business, and educators being partners in business education, in helping to train the young people for business and office careers; and
- WHEREAS: The observance of Business Education Week will be climaxed in the MBEI/NCBEA Convention of the Minnesota Business Educators and North Central Business Education Association on May 1, 2, 3, in honor of the instructors, administrators, exhibitors, and representatives of business organizations cooperating in sponsoring this event;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of April 27 through May 3, 1980, as

MINNESOTA BUSINESS EDUCATION WEEK

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further urge the citizens of this state to take appropriate cognizance of this time.
