WHEREAS: Nutrition is the substance of which life is made and by which life is sustained; and

WHEREAS: The quality of food the individual consumes each day plays a vital role in his health throughout the life cycle; and

WHEREAS: There is a need for continuing nutrition education and a massive effort to enhance family nutrition practices;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 1980, to be

NATIONAL NUTRITION MONTH

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further encourage all citizens to become concerned about their nutrition and the nutrition of others in the hope of achieving optimum health for both today and tomorrow.
