WHEREAS: The over 700 potato growers of the State of Minnesota have contribute significantly to the national harvest of potatoes and to the state's economy and

WHEREAS: The potato is a superior value to the American consumer, both in cost and nutrition; and

WHEREAS: Potatoes have taken the lead in fresh produce by becoming the first fresh vegetable to have a nutritional label; and

WHEREAS: The versatile potato can help consumers prepare nutritious low cost meals; and

WHEREAS: The potato is America's favorite vegetable;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February, 1980, to be

POTATO LOVERS' MONTH

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further encourage consumers to take advantage of the abundant nutritious and low cost vegetable.
