WHEREAS: Top management leadership is one of the most important elements in a well-rounded safety effort; and

WHEREAS: A great humanistic effort has been put forth by Theodore Deikel in initiating the "Take A Taxi On Us" program; and

WHEREAS: This program was the result of a tragic automobile accident which occurred in 1976 during the holiday season; and

WHEREAS: The "Take A Taxi On Us" policy is a way of telling employees and their communities that there is great concern over their lives and safety; and

WHEREAS: The program costs almost nothing in comparison to the potential tragedies it avoids, and we can all slowly but surely help to solve a major national problem; and

WHEREAS: This effort has been made a year-round program with special emphasis during the holiday season;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of December to be

TAKE A TAXI ON US MONTH

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further encourage others to explore this concept.
