CORRECTED ORDINANCE NO. 7 - 1979 ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN PROPERTY ADJOINING THE CITY OF PAYNESVILLE

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borrough; and

WHEREAS, this territory borders upon the city limits of city of Paynesville and is deemed to be light in the character except the highways aforementioned which cannot be zoned.

WHEREAS, the property has access to city water and sewer and has been developed to some degree and is in a position for further development.

WHEREAS, the previous ordinance as passed had an incorrect legal description, and it is necessary to correct the ordinance as passed with the proper legal description.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Paynesville organs;

Section 1. TERRITORY ANNEXED. The corporate limits of the City of Paynesville, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, which territory is now and has heretofore been adjacent to the incorporated limits of the City of Paynesville:

All that part of the East One-half of the Northeast Quarter (E. ½ of N.E. ¼) of Section Sixteen (16) in Township One Hundred and Twenty-two (122) North and of Range Thirty-two (32) West, described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the Northwest Corner thereof, thence running South on the One-sixteenth line Three Hundred and Seventy-five and Seven-tenths (375.7) feet to the North Fifty (50) foot right of way line of the Soo Line Railroad, thence running Southeasterly on and along said North railway right of way line One Hundred and Fifty on a line parallel to the aforementioned One-sixteenth line Four Hundred and Six and One-tenth (406.1) feet to the section line, and thence running West on and along the section line One Hundred and Fifty (150) feet to the point of beginning and there terminating; said tract containing 1.35 acres more or less, and being subject to a 33 foot right of way along the North line thereof, and,

The East One Hundred feet (100') of the West Two Hundred Fifty feet (250') of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¼ NE¾) of Section 16, Township 122, Range 32, Stearns County, Minnesota, which lies Northerly of the Northerly right of way line of the Soo Line Railroad in Stearns County, Minnesota, and

foregoing description and bounded as described is approximately three (3) acres more or less.

Section 3. FILING. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor, and the Register of Deeds of which the property is located and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 4. ZONING. The highways hereinbefore stated cannot be zoned. The remainder of the annexed property shall be zoned as light industrial.

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Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ANNEXATION. The crainers shall take effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3, and approval pursuant to Minnesota Statutes. The City Council does, however, specifically ordain that taxes due and payable during the year 1979 shall be payable by the County

Auditor to the Paynesville Town Board.
