WHEREAS: The Minnesota High School League is sponsoring the sportsman project in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota State High School League has asked the school Minnesota to take part and be involved in this project; and

WHEREAS: The Coon Rapids Senior High School has announced their commit to the Minnesota State High School League and to Region 4AA; and

WHEREAS: They have tried to build interest in sportsmanship within school and the community through the adoption of higher standards sportsmanship; and

WHEREAS: The entire month of March will be filled with state tournament in basketball, girls' gymnastics, hockey, boys swimming, and wrestling and

SPORTSMANSHIP MONTH




