

Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Minnesota High School League is sponsoring the sportsman project in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota State High School League has asked the school Minnesota to take part and be involved in this project, and

WHEREAS: The Coon Rapids Senior High School has announced their commit to the Minnesota State High School League and to Region 4AA; and

WHEREAS: They have tried to build interest in sportsmanship within school and the community through the adoption of higher standard sportsmanship; and

WHEREAS: The entire month of March will be filled with state tournament in basketball, girls' gymnastics, hockey, boys swimming, and wrest and

WHEREAS: A state's sportsmanship award will be presented to the sch following an evaluation of their teams' coaches, cheerleaders, b student and adult fans in hockey, and both girls and boys basket games;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minneso hereby proclaim the month of March, 1980, as
