



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The American Association of University Women is the largest (188,000 members and 900 colleges and universities) and oldest national organization for the advancement of women, education and lifelong learning; and

WHEREAS: Members of AAUW have been able to continue their intellectual growth, to further the advancement of women and to discharge their special responsibilities to society for almost 100 years; and

WHEREAS: AAUW is currently engaged in an all-out action campaign for women's equity called ACTION FOR EQUITY, which is an educational effort to increase awareness of the issues involved in achieving equity for women and a political effort to win ratification of the Equal Rights Amendment;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of March 16 through March 23, 1980, to be

AAUW - ACTION FOR EQUITY WEEK

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eleventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred eighty, and of the State the one hundred twenty-second.
