



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Campus Carnival is an enjoyable, exciting sign of spring in the University community, involving thousands of persons as participants and spectators; and

WHEREAS: In the past, we have donated to the American Lung Association of Hennepin County for four years, and before that many other local philanthropies totaling over a quarter of a million dollars; and

WHEREAS: Carni '80 will be donating their proceeds to the 'CARNI YOUTH PROJECT', a program unique in its aims in developing the potential of terminally ill and chronically ill adolescents in a wilderness experience; and

WHEREAS: This year's Carni will include more student organizations than before as well as including a promotional night with the high schools in the Twin City Area on Thursday, April 17, 1980;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 17th, 18th, and 19th, 1980, to be

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further encourage all citizens to participate in this worthwhile event.
