STATE OF MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF STATE F. I L E D

WHEREAS: This is the year of the Family; and

Secretary of State

WHEREAS: Drama/Theatre for Youth and the Family is the only teacher of morals and conduct and high ideals that never bores the pupil but always leaves them sorry the lesson is over; and

WHEREAS: Drama/Theatre for Youth and the Family is a place where there is no distinction made on the basis of economic class, race, sex, and national origin; and

WHEREAS: Drama / Theatre for Youth and the Family brings entertainment, psychological growth, educational exposure, aesthetic appreciation and the development of future audiences to the arts; and

WHEREAS: There is a need for high standards in creative drama and theatre for youth and the family through artistically unified productions that achieve the highest possible quality in each of the areas of theatrical and dramatic endeavors;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 5 through May 11, 1980, to be

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further encourage the people of the State of Minnesota to recognize the need for continuing to raise the standard of theatre for the child audience, as well as the entire family.
