WHEREAS: Gospel Music is an integral part of our American heritage and music culture; and

WHEREAS: The composers, authors, publishers, and performers of Gospel Fiusic are individuals who have dedicated their lives to God through their various talents; and

WHEREAS: Gospel Music is entertaining, but more important, spiritually uplifting and inspirational; and

WHEREAS: Gospel Music is part of the heritage that elevates the human spirit, delights the ear, fills the heart with joy and brings us nearer to God;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 1980, to be

GOSPEL MUSIC MONTH

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further urge all citizens to recognize the importance of Gospel Music to Christian life and worship in this state.
