

Proclamation

WHEREAS: A Health Fair offers health education in several forms, as well as screening for non-symptomatic diseases such as anemia, high blood pressure, glaucoma, and vision problems; and

WHEREAS: A Health Fair is an intensive, area-wide promotion campaign based on a week-long series of local Health Fairs held throughout a major metropolitan area, which includes an intensive follow-up program; and

WHEREAS: Education is the underlying and dominant focus of the three main aspects of the Health Fair -- health screening tests, counseling, and follow-up; and

WHEREAS: The Health Fair will aid you in learning about your health needs and ways in which you can help yourself to better health by your own efforts and better use of the available resources; and

WHEREAS: WTCN-TV is sponsoring a Community Health Fair Week the week of April 14 through April 20;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 14 through April 20, 1980, to be

HEALTH FAIR WEEK

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further encourage the citizens of this state to help themselves to better health through their own efforts and better knowledge of the resources available in their communities.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eleventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred eighty, and of the State the one hundred twenty-second.
