HEREAS: The West Side Citizens Bank Club of Delano annually holds a benefit dance for the University of Minnesota's Hubert H. Humphrey Cancer Research Fund; and

HEREAS: Last Year's dance attracted 2100 people, and raised \$7000 for this worthy cause, and with the help of WDGY Radio, WTCN-TV and WCCO-TV, this year's dance may be even more successful; and

HEREAS: This dance will be attended by a broad range of Minnesota citizens, including Marilyn Sellars and Betty Rydell, personalities from college and professional sports organizations and members of the Humphrey family; and

HEREAS: This year, on April 12, 1980 the 2nd Annual Bowling Tournament will be held at Lynbrook Bowl in Brooklyn Center, and on April 13, 1980, the 3rd Annual Benefit Dance will be held at Medina Ballroom in Hamel, Minnesota; and

HEREAS: This tribute reflects the great regard which the people of Minnesota carry for the late Senator Humphrey and the dedication we all have to conquering this disease which claims so many Minnesotans each year;

W, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 12 and April 13, 1980, to be
