

## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Mobile and modular housing remain the only affordable alternative to single family home ownership for a majority of Minnesotans entering the home market; and

WHEREAS: The Federal Code to which these homes are manufactured meets or exceeds the energy requirements of site-built construction; and

WHEREAS: More Minnesotans from all walks of life each year are finding the lifestyle of mobile and modular housing to be enjoyable and practical; and

WHEREAS: The manufactured housing industry is an important segment of Minnesota's economy providing a needed product and Jobs for our citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 28 through May 5, 1980, to be

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further urge all citizens to mark its celebration.
