



Proclamation

HEREAS: Coin clubs throughout the nation are founded to promote the growth and sharing of numismatic knowledge among members and the general public, and to foster widespread appreciation of coin collecting as a hobby; and

HEREAS: The U & I Coin Club and other clubs and collectors throughout Minnesota share these goals; and

HEREAS: 1980 marks the 56th annual observance of National Coin Week in the United States; and

HEREAS: The American Numismatic Association, the U & I Coin Club, and coin clubs and collectors throughout Minnesota and the Nation will participate in this observance, "Numismatics -- A Study of Man's Roots";

OW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 13 through April 20, 1980, to be

NATIONAL COIN WEEK

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further encourage all citizens to better inform themselves about this interesting, educational hobby.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eleventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred eighty, and of the State the one hundred twenty-second.
