WHEREAS: The Minnesota Academy of Science is designated as local sponsoring agency for the International Science and Engineering Fair to be known as the 1980 Minnesota ISEF; and

WHEREAS: This event will focus worldwide attention and bring honor and credit to the scientific and technological community of Minnesota with special emphasis on our science-oriented youth; and

WHEREAS: Leading businesses, organizations, institutions, and the people of this state have pledged and are providing professional, financial, and personal support to assure successful accomplishment of the goals of ISEF for now and for the future; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Academy has been a leading proponent of similar programs in education and human betterment through technological advancement and guidance for more than 100 years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 4 through May 10, 1980, to be

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY WEEK

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare his proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. I further urge all citizens to cooperate with and participate in educationally enriching functions of that time.
