

ORDINANCE NO. 943.9

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF EDGERTON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Edgerton, Minnesota by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Edgerton, Minnesota:

A tract of land in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 105 North, Range 44 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Pipestone County Minnesota, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot 7, Block 2 of Mulders Addition to the Village of Edgerton; thence West along the Southerly boundary of Elizabeth Street a distance of 1059.40 feet to a point on the East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, said point to be known as the Point of Beginning of the tract to be described; thence continuing West along said Southerly line a distance of 403.25 feet to a point on the East line of the Osborn Township Cemetary; thence Southerly along said East boundary, a distance of 550.35 feet to the Northerly right of way of the Chicago Milwaukie St. Paul and Pacific Railroad; thence Southeasterly along said right of way a distance of 328.59 feet; thence at right angles to the centerline of said railroad and in a Northeasterly direction, a distance of 25 feet; thence Southeasterly on a line parallel to and 75 feet Northerly of the centerline of said railroad, a distance of 140.90 feet to a point on said East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter; thence Northerly on said East line a distance of 793.65 feet to the Point of Beginning.

This tract contains 6.3 acres more or less subject to easements now on record in said county and state.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 6.3 acres.

Section 3. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Edgerton, Minnesota and of the territory affected; (2) that the

territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Edgerton, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City of Edgerton, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication pursuant to MSA 414.033.

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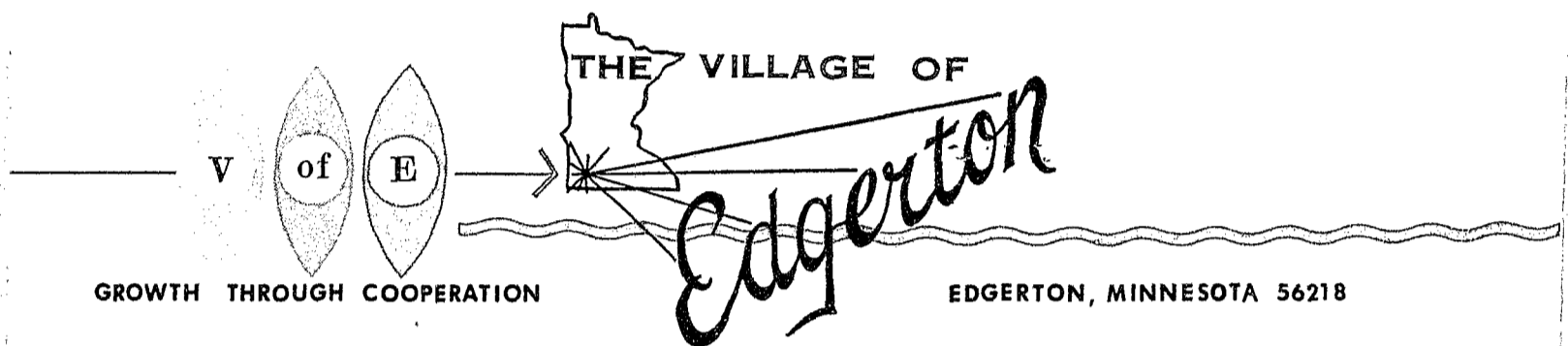
