

Proclamation

WHEREAS: LESS THAN FORTY YEARS AGO, SIX MILLION JEWS, AS WELL AS MILLIONS OF OTHERS WERE MURDERED IN NAZI CONCENTRATION CAMPS

AS PART OF A PLANNED PROGRAM OF EXTERMINATION; AND

THE PEOPLE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA SHOULD ALWAYS WHEREAS:

REMEMBER THE TERRIBLE ATROCITIES COMMITTED BY THE NAZIS SO

THAT THEY WILL NEVER BE REPEATED; AND

WHEREAS: THE PEOPLE OF THE UNITED STATES SHOULD REMAIN ETERNALLY

TYRANNY

VIGILANT AGAINST ALL TYRANNY, RECOGNIZING THAT TO PROVIDES A BREEDING GROUND FOR BIGOTRY TO FLOURISH; AND

APRIL 13 HAS BEEN DESIGNATED INTERNATIONALLY AS A DAY OF WHEREAS:

REMEMBRANCE OF VICTIMS OF THE NAZI HOLOCAUST;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF APRIL 13 THROUGH APRIL 19, 1980 TO BE

DAYS OF REMEMBRANCE

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. I FURTHER URGE ALL CITIZENS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO REMEMBER THE ATROCITIES COMMITTED BY THE NAZIS AND TO COMMEMORATE SUCH DAYS WITH APPROPRIATE CEREMONIES AND ACTIVITIES.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED AT THE STATE CAPITOL THIS FIRST DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SECOND.
