



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: For the past twenty-two years the Department of Minnesota, Veterans of Foreign Wars has benefitted from Archie Pavék's many hours of volunteer service to his fellowman, especially the veteran, the widow, and the orphan; and

WHEREAS: Archie Pavék's leadership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars has earned him such titles as All State Commander and National Aide-de-Camp to several National Commanders; and

WHEREAS: The generosity demonstrated on the behalf of Archie Pavék by all the posts and auxiliaries that contributed funds to provide the wheelchair van for the Minnesota Veterans Home is in keeping with the other such outstanding projects for cancer research, Camp Courage, and youth activities;
