

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Thousands of children are raised by a single parent; and

WHEREAS: It is the primary endeavor of conscientous single parents to bring their children to healthy maturity, with the full sense of being loved and accepted as persons, and with the same prospects for normal adulthood as children who mature with their two parents

together; and

WHEREAS: Many of these single parents find encouragement and support through involvement in Singles and Solo Parent Clubs throughout the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Mankato Area Singles and Solo Parents Club is hosting the 1980 Minnesota State Convention on April 18, 19, and 20, 1980, when solo parents from around the State can gather together to share common problems and ideas;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 18 through April 29, 1980 to be

SINGLE AND SOLO PARENTS WEEKEND

in Minnesota, and urge all Minnesotans to give special attention and consideration to the single parents in their communities, and reflect upon the special needs of this group of citizens.
