WHEREAS: The beef industry is one if the most important of the Minnesota

WHEREAS: Beef is one of the most nutritious foods, rich in protein and all

health-building factors, scientifically proven beneficial to people

of all ages, from the very young to the very old; and

WHEREAS: An increased recognition, purchase and consumption by Minnesotans

of the high quality beef products of this state will stimulate

increased nutrition and jobs for the people of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Chapter of the American National CowBelles and the

Beef Industry Council are cooperating with the producer-elected Minnesota Beef Council in sponsoring this 27th annual "Beef for Father's Day," opening the nation-wide summer cookout season; and

WHEREAS: It is important that the people of Minnesota recognize the impor-

tance of our Beef Industry and its contributions to the strength

and welfare of our great state and nation; and

WHEREAS: Father's Day is an appropriate time to honor Minnesota's Beef
