WHEREAS: WARM WEATHER BRINGS OUT BICYCLISTS OF ALL AGES, BUT ALSO BRINGS THE RISK OF DANGEROUS BICYCLE ACCIDENTS; AND

WHEREAS: HALF OF ALL BICYCLE ACCIDENTS INVOLVE CHILDREN BETWEEN FIVE AND FIFTEEN YEARS OF AGE; AND

WHEREAS: THREE OUT OF FOUR BICYCLE / AUTO ACCIDENTS ARE THE FAULT OF THE CYCLIST; AND

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA IS A NATIONAL LEADER IS PROGRAMS WHICH ENHANCE THE SAFETY OF BICYCLISTS AND PROMOTE COURTEOUS, RATIONAL RIDER PRAC-TICES;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF MAY, 1980 TO BE

BICYCLE SAFETY MONTH

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER. I URGE ALL CITIZENS TO TAKE DECISIVE ACTIONS WHICH WILL ASSURE GREATER SAFETY FOR BICYCLISTS IN OUR STATE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-THIRD DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SECOND.
