



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Moorhead State University Concery Choir will depart on May 30 for a concert tour of Europe and will sing in the principal cities of that continent; and

WHEREAS: The 1980 Europe Concert Tour has been made possible largely through the fundraising efforts of students themselves, with assistance from other sources including community donations; and

WHEREAS: The 1980 Europe Concert Tour will further enrich the mutual benefits in cultural experience, education and international understanding gained by the members of the choir and their audiences;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim and designate the Moorhead State University Concert Choir as

and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature. Further, I commission all of the Choir members to be Minnesota's Choral Ambassadors of Good Will, with my best wishes for a most successful Concert Tour in Europe.
