WHEREAS: The Junior National Organization of the Deaf is a nationwide

organization dedicated to the promotion of the social, cultural, and educational welfare of deaf youth, and to assist them in

developing meaningful and productive lives; and

WHEREAS: The Junior National Association of the Deaf has ninety-two chapters

in the United States and over four thousand and six hundred members;

and

WHEREAS: The Junior National Association of the Deaf has designated the week

of May 5 through May 11, 1980 as Junior N.A.D. Deaf Awareness Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 5 through May 11, 1980 to be

JUNIOR NAD DEAF AWARENESS WEEK

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. Further, I call upon all citizens, educational institutions and civic organizations to join with me in support of the outstanding work being performed by the Junior National Association of the Deaf to benefit and enrich the lives of all our youth.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital this twenty-third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty, and of the State the one hundred and twenty-second.
