WHEREAS: Cystic Fibrosis is the most common genetic disease in America; and

WHEREAS: Cystic Fibrosis is the number one genetic killer of children; and

WHEREAS: Cystic Fibrosis is the most serious, incurable of all lung diseases; and

WHEREAS: It is important to detect this disease as early as possible; and

WHEREAS: Kissing your baby is designed to help parents recognize one of the warning signs of Cystic Fibrosis;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 11 through May 17 to be

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same. Further, I encourage all parents to look for important signs, including the salty taste of the skin, and alert doctors to the possibility of Cystic Fibrosis.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty, and of the State the one hundred and twenty-second.
