WHEREAS: ALL AMERICANS SHOULD TAKE PRIDE IN OUR LAWS, LEGAL INSTITUTIONS, AND THOSE ACCREDITED REPRESENTATIVES OF OUR JUDICIAL SYSTEM WHICH SEEKS TO SECURE THE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE; AND

WHEREAS: The Law is a human institutions, reflecting the moods, customs, and modes of conduct of our people, and is truly our own creation; and

WHEREAS: Today's Lawyers play many vital roles in the practice of law; as a counselor, giving legal advice; as an advocate, assisting the Courts in the administration of justice; and as a public servant, serving public officials, both elected and appointed, and as legal advisors to many community organizations; and

WHEREAS: On May 1, 1980, our nation will observe Law Day U.S.A. in recognition of our liberties secured by Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. Quie. Governor of the State of Minnesota, do Hereby proclaim May 1, 1980 to be

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I CALL UPON ALL CITIZENS TO JOIN WITH ME IN ITS OBSERVANCE THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN BAR-SPONSORED PROGRAMS, COURT VISITATIONS AND OTHER CEREMONIES AND ACTIVITIES IN RECOGNITION OF THIS IMPORTANT DAY.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed this twenty-third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty, and of the State the one hundred and twenty-second.
