Mr. Jacobson of the committee on motor vehicles offers the following resolution:

WHEREAS, your committee has under consideration a number of bills relating to the enactment of a law taxing gasoline used in driving motor vehicles, the adoption by a considerable majority of the constitutional amendment authorizing such a tax, and providing that the proceeds shall be used for the maintenance and construction of state highways, indicating that it is the wish of the people that such a tax should be imposed,

AND WHEREAS, consideration of the various measures will require a considerable length of time, and inasmuch as the time within which the motor vehicle tax as now imposed may be paid without penalty before February 15th.

AND WHEREAS, owners of motor vehicles may be delaying payment of the 1925 tax in expectation of a reduction in the amount of tax this year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Minnesota House of Representatives that the Secretary of State, who has the collection of such tax, as hereinbefore stated, be and is hereby instructed, through the public press, to inform the public that, in the opinion of this House no change can be made by the Legislature in the present tax on motor vehicles in time to relieve the tax payers of Minnesota from the payment of the tax now due on motor vehicles.
