



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE EDUCATION OF OUR CHILDREN IS ONE OF THE MOST SERIOUS RESPONSIBILITIES UNDERTAKEN BY SOCIETY; AND

WHEREAS: PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS PROVIDE LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES IN A VARIETY OF SUBJECT AREAS, BUILDING FROM THE FOUNDATION OF EACH CHILD'S BASIC READING AND MATH SKILLS; AND

WHEREAS: SOME CHILDREN REQUIRE SPECIAL ASSISTANCE TO PROPERLY DEVELOP THESE CRITICAL MATH AND READING SKILLS; AND

WHEREAS: TITLE I OF THE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION ACT PROVIDES PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS WITH FUNDS FOR ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL AND MATERIALS TO ASSIST THOSE STUDENTS PERFORMING BELOW GRADE LEVEL IN READING AND MATH; AND

WHEREAS: THE EFFECTIVENESS OF TITLE I PROGRAMS IS ENHANCED BY PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT AND PUBLIC UNDERSTANDING OF TITLE I OBJECTIVES AND METHODS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 5 THROUGH MAY 9 TO BE

TITLE I AWARENESS WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE INTERESTED MINNESOTANS TO VISIT A TITLE I PROGRAM, IN ORDER TO BECOME MORE ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN THE PROMOTION OF QUALITY EDUCATION FOR ALL CHILDREN IN OUR STATE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-THIRD DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SECOND.
