



Proclamation

- AS: A NEED EXISTS IN THE UNITED STATES TO ATTEND TO THE WELL-BEING OF MANY FORGOTTEN PEOPLE; AND
- AS: THE WELFARE OF THESE PEOPLE DEPENDS UPON HOW THEIR BASIC NEEDS ARE MET; AND
- AS: THESE BASIC NEEDS INCLUDE GOOD HEALTH, FOOD, DRINKABLE WATER, EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES, FREEDOM FROM ECONOMIC UNCERTAINTY, DECENT HOUSING, AND RIGHTS UNDER THE LAW; AND
- AS: THOUSANDS OF AMERICANS FROM MANY WALKS OF LIFE, AGE GROUPS, AND BACKGROUNDS HAVE SERVED AS VISTA VOLUNTEERS, DEVOTED TO MAKING THEIR COUNTRY AND COMMUNITIES A BETTER PLACE TO LIVE BY WORKING WITH PEOPLE TO ACHIEVE THE DREAM OF SATISFYING THESE BASIC HUMAN NEEDS;

THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF APRIL 20 THROUGH APRIL 26 TO BE

VISTA WEEK

MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I ENCOURAGE ALL CITIZENS TO BE AWARE OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY VISTA VOLUNTEERS AND TO TRANSLATE THIS AWARENESS INTO ACTION BY SERVING THE STATE AND NATION BY VOLUNTEERING.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-THIRD DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SECOND.
