ORDINANCE NO. 943.10

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF EDGERTON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Edgerton, Minnesota, by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Edgerton, Minnesota:

1. The North Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the South Sixty Six (S.66) Feet of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty One (21), Township One Hundred Five (105) North, Range Forty Four (44) West, Osborne Township, Pipestone County, Minnesota.
2. The West Nine Hundred Twenty Four (W. 924) Feet of the South Six Hundred Sixty (S.660) Feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty One (21), Township One Hundred Five (105) North, Range Forty Four (44) West of the 5th P.M.

These tracts of land contain 35.78 acres more or less subject to easements now on record in said county and state.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 35.78 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Edgerton, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

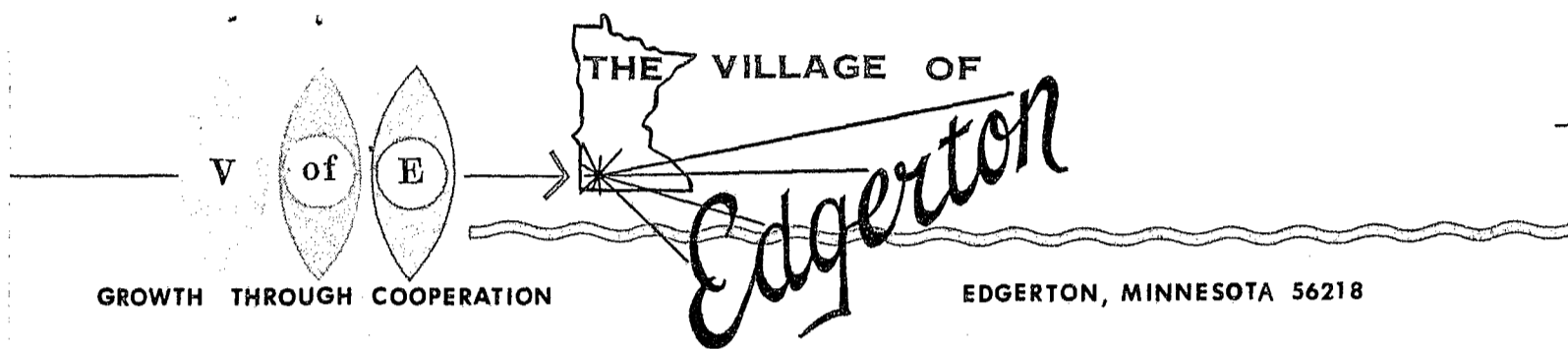
Section 4. Therefore, the City of Edgerton, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City of Edgerton, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after the filing of a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication pursuant to MSA 414.033.

Rick A. Fey, being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as The Edgerton Enterprise and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the Village of Edgerton in the County of Pipestone and it has its known office of issue in the Village of Edgerton in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and devoted exclusively during such regular business hours to the business of this newspaper and business related thereto. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper is made available at single or subscription prices to any person, corporation, partnership or other unincorporated association requesting the newspaper and making the applicable payment. (8) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least one year preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (9) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
