ORDINANCE NO. 50  
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE  
CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE  
CITY OF ROLLINGSTONE  
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN  
UNINCORPORATED LAND ABUTTING  
UPON THE CITY LIMITS

*Rollingstone*

WHEREAS, a petition dated August 6, 1979,  
requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described  
was duly presented to the City Council on September 4, 1979,  
and

WHEREAS, the land embraced within the area described in  
the petition is unplatted land, no part of which is included  
within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough;  
and consists of 3.15 acres; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the owners, and

WHEREAS, copies of the said petition were duly filed with  
the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the concerned Town Board,  
the City of Rollingstone and the County Board of Commissioners  
more than 90 days prior hereto; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received  
from the Town Board, the County Board of Commissioners, or any  
other governmental body; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the  
City of Rollingstone limits at the North boundary thereof, and

WHEREAS, the desirability of annexation<sup>of</sup> said land has been  
carefully considered.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of Rollingstone does ordain:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the  
annexation will be to the best interests of the City and of the  
territory affected: (2) that the territory described herein  
abuts upon the City limits and is urban or suburban in character;  
and (3) none of said territory is now included within the limits  
of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof;

That part of the East half of the Northeast quarter ( $E\frac{1}{2}$  of  $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Six (6), Township One hundred seven (107) North, of Range Eight (8), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Winona County Minnesota, described as follows:  
Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of said Northeast Quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Six (6); thence on an assumed bearing of North along the east line of the Northeast Quarter of said Northeast Quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Six (6), a distance of five hundred eighteen and fifteen hundredths (518.15) feet, thence West, a distance of one hundred forty and no hundredths (140.00) feet; thence South  $40^{\circ} 58' 29''$  West, a distance of two hundred eighteen and forty hundredths (218.40) feet to a point in the center of Rollingsstone Creek; thence South  $8^{\circ} 17' 50''$  West along the center of said Creek, a distance of fifty-nine and sixty-one hundredths (59.61) feet; thence South  $24^{\circ} 23' 58''$  West along the center of said Creek, a distance of One hundred seventeen and four hundredths (117.04) feet; thence South  $35^{\circ} 51' 14''$  East a distance of two hundred forty-four and seventy-nine hundredths (244.79) feet to the Northwesternly corner of Lot Thirteen (13), Block Four (4), of Greden and Speltz's Addition to the City of Rollingsstone, Minnesota; thence North  $54^{\circ} 08' 46''$  East along the Northerly line of said Lot Thirteen (13), a distance of seven and ten hundredths (7.10) feet to a point on the North line of said Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Six (6); thence North  $88^{\circ} 02'$  East along the North line, a distance of One hundred ninety-one and Fourteen hundredths (191.14) feet to the point of beginning.  
Except therefrom a triangular piece described as follows:  
Commencing at the Northeast corner of the  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of the  $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 6 Township 107 North, Range Eight West thence West along the North line of said  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 6 a distance of 33 feet; thence North  $45^{\circ}$  East 46.6 feet to the east line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 6; thence South along said east line a distance of 33 feet to place of beginning.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk and the County Auditor.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.


