



## Proclamation

REASONS: MINNESOTA HAS A PROUD HISTORY OF ENCOURAGING QUALITY AND DIVERSITY IN EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES; AND

REASONS: DR. OSCAR A. ANDERSON HAS HELPED IMPROVE SUCH OPPORTUNITIES FOR THOUSANDS OF STUDENTS IN HIS ROLE AS PRESIDENT OF AUGSBURG COLLEGE, IN MINNEAPOLIS, FOR SEVENTEEN YEARS; AND

REASONS: DR. OSCAR A. ANDERSON FORGED A NEW ROLE IN THE 1960'S AND 70'S FOR AUGSBURG AS A COLLEGE OF THE AMERICAN LUTHERAN CHURCH; AND

REASONS: THE COLLEGE'S NEW DIRECTIONS INCLUDED SERVICE TO AND PARTICIPATION IN METROPOLITAN COMMUNITY LIFE AND AFFAIRS OF THIS STATE; AND
