

Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE American Society of Mechanical Engineers is observing, during this year of 1980, its 100th year of service to the people of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERS IS DEDICATED TO THE ADVANCEMENT OF THE ART AND SCIENCE OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERING AND ITS APPLICATION TO THE IMPROVEMENT OF SOCIAL CONDITIONS OF MANKIND; AND

WHEREAS: The people, industries, institutions and enterprises of the State of Minnesota have benefitted from the contributions of the members of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers during the Society's first one hundred years; and

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA RECOGNIZES, ACKNOWLEDGES AND APPRECIATES THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERS DURING THE SOCIETY'S FIRST ONE HUNDRED YEARS; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA RECOGNIZES, ACKNOWLEDGES AND APPRECIATES THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERS AND ITS MEMBERS, FOR THEIR CONTRIBUTIONS TO CIVILIZATION;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE AND COMMEND

THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERS

FOR A CENTURY OF SERVICE TO THE STATE OF MINNESOTA AND THE UNITED STATES AS A WHOLE, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-FIRST DAY OF MAY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EXCHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THIRD.
