

Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE REFUGEES OF CAMBODIA, THAILAND, AND OTHER COUNTRIES ARE EXPERIENCING GREAT SUFFERING AND NEED; AND

WHEREAS: CITIZENS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND THE UNITED STATES AS A WHOLE, ARE ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN EFFORTS TO BRING RELIEF TO THIS SUFFERING THROUGH THE DEVOTION OF TIME, TALENTS, AND ENERGY TO VARIOUS PROGRAMS AND FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES; AND

WHEREAS: Among the many activities underway in Minnesota, four Minnesota men are planning to climb Alaska's Mount McKinley for the purpose of raising money for needy refugees; and

WHEREAS: These four men will face great danger and many difficult challenges in this effort, and truly deserve the support of Minnesotans for their self-sacrificing efforts;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 26 THROUGH JUNE 1 TO BE

CLIMB MOUNT MCKINLEY FOR REFUGEES WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL MINNESOTANS TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE VARIOUS OPPORTUNITIES OFFERED TO BRING ASSISTANCE TO THE NEEDY PEOPLE OF CAMBODIA AND THAILAND, AND TO GIVE RECOGNITION AND SUPPORT FOR THE FOUR MINNESOTA MEN PLANNING TO CLIMB MOUNT MCKINLEY FOR REFUGEES.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-FIRST DAY OF MAY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THIRD.
