WHEREAS: THE CONTINENTAL SOCIETIES, INCORPORATED ARE BEGINNING THEIR TWENTY-FIFTH YEAR OF SERVICE TO DISADVANTAGED CHILDREN AND YOUTH; AND

WHEREAS: The members have instituted a programatic thrust indicative of their concern and commitment to uplift and encourage the development of children and youth; and

WHEREAS: The Societies' twenty-fifth conclave is being held in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: THE CONTINENTAL SOCIETIES, INCORPORATED WAS FORMALLY INCORPORATED AS A NATIONAL BODY IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA; AND
