- WHEREAS: NATIONAL TENNIS WEEK IS A NATIONWIDE EVENT SUPPORTED BY THE PRESIDENT'S COUNCIL ON PHYSICAL FITNESS AND SPORTS, THE UNITED STATES PROFESSIONAL TENNIS ASSOCIATION, THE NATIONAL TENNIS ASSOCIATION, THE TENNIS FOUNDATION OF NORTH AMERICA, AND THE UNITED STATES TENNIS ASSOCIATION; AND
