ORDINANCE NO. 414

AN ORDINANCE extending the corporate limits of the City of Litchfield, Minnesota, to include certain unincorporated unplatted land completely surrounded by land within the limits of the City of Litchfield.

WHEREAS, Roman B. Nistler and Irene T. Nistler, husband and wife are owners in fee of 0.62 acres of land as hereinafter described which is completely surrounded by land lying within the limits of the City of Litchfield; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described is 0.62 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of any other incorporated city, village or borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Litchfield, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION I.

The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City and to the land affected; (2) that the land described herein is entirely within and surrounded by land within the municipal limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said land is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

SECTION II. Land Annexed.

The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectively as if it had originally been a part thereof: Land in Meeker County, Minnesota, to-wit:

Part of Government Lot Four (4), Section Fourteen (14), Township One Hundred Nineteen North (119-N), Range Thirty-one West (31-W), described as follows: Beginning at a point on the shore of Lake Ripley at the Southeast corner of Government Lot Four (4), Section Fourteen (14), Township One Hundred Nineteen North (119-N), Range Thirty-one West (31-W), thence North along the East line of said Lot a distance of 277.5 feet, thence due West 100.0 feet, thence South and parallel to the East line of said Lot a distance of 266.5 feet to a point on the shoreline of Lake Ripley, thence in a Southeasterly direction along the shoreline of said Lake a distance of 100.9 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.62 acre.

SECTION III. Filing.

The City clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the Meeker County Auditor.

SECTION IV. Effective Date.

This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of certified copies as directed in Section III.
