ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MOORHEAD TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS AT THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY THEREOF. WHEREAS, a certain Petition requesting annexation of the land hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council: and WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is less than 200 acres of unplatted land no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all of the owners of the real estate involved; and WHEREAS, no bjections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts upon the City limits at the southerly boundary of said city.

## ORDINANCE NO. 693

ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MOORHEAD TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS AT THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY THEREOF.

WHEREAS, a certain Petition requesting annexation of the land hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is less than 200 acres of unplatted land no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all of the owners of the real estate involved; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts upon the City limits at the southerly boundary of said city,

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Moorhead, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby determine (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is urban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

thence West perpendicular to said Right-of-Way line a distance of 234.30 feet to a point of intersection with the East line of Block One (1), of Lillian Briggs Subdivision of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE\%SW\%) of Section Twenty (20); thence North along said East line of said Lillian Briggs Subdivision a distance of 365.32 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot One (1), of Block One (1) of said Lillian Briggs Subdivision; thence East along the North line of said Lot One (1), Block One (1), as extended to the East a distance of 234.30 feet to a point of intersection with the said West Right-of-Way; thence South along the West Right-of-Way line a distance of 362.50 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 3. FILING. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
