



Proclamation

WHEREAS: CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY AND ABUSE IS AN INCREASING PROBLEM IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: THE CITIZENS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA HAVE BECOME INCREASINGLY CONCERNED ABOUT THIS PROBLEM; AND

WHEREAS: THE BELTRAMI COUNTY COUNCIL ON CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY HAS BEEN FORMED TO PROVIDE A UNIFIED EFFORT TO DEAL WITH THIS PROBLEM IN NORTHERN MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: THE BELTRAMI COUNTY COUNCIL ON CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY IS PROMOTING AWARENESS OF ALCOHOL USE AND ABUSE; AND

WHEREAS: THE EVENT HAS BEEN NAMED THE NORTH COUNTRY ALCOHOL AWARENESS WEEK AND IS SCHEDULED TO BE HELD THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 5 THROUGH 11, 1980;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 5 THROUGH 11, 1980 TO BE

NORTH COUNTRY ALCOHOL AWARENESS WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL MINNESOTANS TO SUPPORT EFFORTS TO DEAL WITH THE PROBLEMS OF ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-SEVENTH DAY OF MAY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THIRD.
