



Proclamation

WHEREAS: FATHERS RENDER INVALUABLE SERVICE TO LABOR, INDUSTRY, COMMERCE AND EVERY FIELD OF ENDEAVOR WHICH IS NECESSARY FOR THE FAMILY, COMMUNITY, PUBLIC WELFARE AND THE POSTERITY AND HEALTH OF THE NATION; AND

WHEREAS: WE LOOK TO THE FATHER IN THE HOME AS A VITAL PARTNER IN GUIDING THE CHILDREN AND INSPIRING IN THEM THE IMPORTANCE OF THE MORALS AND ETHICS AND THE FUNDAMENTAL LAWS WHICH GOVERN TRUE BROTHERHOOD AND IMPRESS UPON THEM THE VALUE OF ALL CIVIC VIRTUES AND RESPONSIBILITY WHICH ARE THE REQUESTS OF GOOD AMERICAN CITIZENSHIP; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS APPROPRIATE THAT WE DESIGNATE ONE DAY IN THE YEAR TO PAY TRIBUTE IN A BROAD CONCURRENCE OF PUBLIC EXPRESSION TO THE RESPECT AND REVERENCE IN WHICH WE HOLD THE FATHER AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF OUR AMERICAN SOCIETY;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SUNDAY JUNE 15, 1980 TO BE

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-SEVENTH DAY OF MAY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THIRD.
