Proclamation

WHEREAS: FOR YEARS GOLF HAS PROVIDED ENTERTAINMENT, RELAXATION, EXERCISE AND ATHLETIC COMPETITION FOR PEOPLE OF ALL AGES; AND

WHEREAS: MORE AND MORE YOUNG PEOPLE ARE BEING INTRODUCED TO THE CHALLENGES AND EXCITEMENT OF GOLF; AND

WHEREAS: RECOGNIZING THIS INCREASED INTEREST AMONG YOUNG PEOPLE, THE PROFESSIONAL GOLFERS ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA, (PGA), CREATED ITS NON-PROFIT JUNIOR GOLF FOUNDATION TO SUPPORT AN AGGRESSIVE GOLF DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM THAT WILL HELP JUNIORS DEVELOP THEIR SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE OF THE RULES AND ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME; AND

WHEREAS: THE JUNIOR GOLF FOUNDATION WILL HELP PGA MEMBERS PROVIDE MATERIALS, ORGANIZATION AND ENCOURAGEMENT TO JUNIOR PLAYERS THROUGH JUNIOR GOLF PROGRAM KITS, JUNIOR GOLF INSTRUCTIONAL FILMS, AND GUIDELINES FOR LOCAL JUNIOR GOLF PROGRAMS - IN ADDITION TO ASSISTING IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF JUNIOR GOLF ACADEMIES AND PROMOTION OF GOLF AT JUNIOR HIGH AND HIGH SCHOOL LEVELS; AND

WHEREAS: ON JULY 1, 1980, THE SECOND ANNUAL GRAND SLAM OF GOLF WILL BE HELD AT THE HAZELTINE NATIONAL GOLF CLUB, IN CHASKA, MINNESOTA, TO BENEFIT THE PGA JUNIOR GOLF FOUNDATION;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JUNE 29 THROUGH JULY 5, 1980 TO BE

JUNIOR GOLF WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE MANY BENEFITS OF GOLF, AND TO ENCOURAGE A YOUNG PERSON TO ENJOY THIS POPULAR SPORT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINETEENTH DAY OF JUNE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THIRD.
