



Proclamation

WHEREAS: OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE IS ONE OF THE TWO COMPLETE SCHOOLS OF MEDICINE WHOSE PHYSICIANS PROVIDE THE FULL RANGE OF MEDICAL SERVICES; AND

WHEREAS: DOCTORS OF OSTEOPATHY, D.O.s, ALTHOUGH ONLY FIVE PERCENT OF THE COUNTRY'S PHYSICIAN MANPOWER, PROVIDE TOTAL HEALTH CARE TO MORE THAN TEN PERCENT OF THE PUBLIC, SOME 20 MILLION AMERICANS; AND

WHEREAS: STUDIES FUNDED BY A KELLOGG FOUNDATION GRANT REVEAL THAT THE OSTEOPATHIC PROFESSION WILL MORE THAN DOUBLE IN THE NEXT TWENTY YEARS, MAKING IT AMERICA'S FASTEST GROWING HEALTH CARE PROFESSION; AND

WHEREAS: THE PROFESSION, PREDOMINATELY COMPOSED OF FAMILY PHYSICIANS, IS HELPING TO MEET THE SHORTAGE OF PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIANS; AND

WHEREAS: OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIANS ALREADY MAKE A SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTION TO HEALTH CARE IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND WILL MAKE AN EVEN GREATER CONTRIBUTION IN THE FUTURE, DUE TO THEIR PROJECTED RATE OF GROWTH;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JUNE 1 THROUGH JUNE 7, 1980 TO BE

O S T E O P A T H I C M E D I C I N E W E E K

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL CITIZENS TO OBSERVE THIS WEEK WITH PROPER RECOGNITION.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIRST DAY OF JUNE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THIRD.
